RESOLUTION


WHEREAS, in light of extremely dry weather during the last few weeks over the area, and the conditions of the dry vegetation and water situation, it has become apparent that substantial economic losses could be suffered by producers/farmers and/or ranchers in Bannock County; and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code § 31-828 authorizes the County Commissioners to perform all acts that may be necessary to the full discharge of the duties of the chief executive authority of the County Government; and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code § 46-1011 provides that the Bannock County Commissioners may declare a local disaster emergency in excess of seven days;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that a disaster declaration is hereby made in Bannock County for the significant economic losses anticipated for Bannock County producers/farmers and/or ranchers due to drought-like conditions, and shall remain in effect until further notice, or until otherwise terminated by resolution, whichever occurs sooner. Bannock County requests assistance from all other entities and resources, including but not limited to the State of Idaho and the federal Government and their respective agencies.


