Generators: If you are supplying your own, you must have GCFI protection, be portable, and be under 85 decibels at 15 feet away. Power supply provided by Bannock County will be either the NEMA 14-50 receptacle or a 50 amp – 125/250-volt California-style receptacle. Standard 120 v 20 a receptacle will also be available. Voltage and total amperage must be submitted for Bannock County provided generators.
