WHEREAS, pursuant to Idaho Code 2-216(2), the Administrative District Judge may require availability for jury service for a period not to exceed six (6) months in any county within the judicial district; and


WHEREAS, Franklin County has adopted a new jury management system and it is administratively efficient to abbreviate the current six (6) month availability requirement to end on June 30, 2023, instead of August 14, 2023.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the current Franklin County jury service requirement end on June 30, 2023. Starting July 1, 2023, availability for jury service shall be for six (6) months.

Persons who were granted a postponement of their service prior to the effective date of this Order shall be required to serve under the new jury service term set under this Order.
