ELECTION INFORMATION

NATIONAL, STATE, CITY, COUNTY

Voter Qualifications

- United States citizenship
- 18 years of age or older on or before election day
- Resident of Idaho and a resident in the county for 30 days
- Duly registered. Voters must re-register to vote if they have
 - changed their name
 - changed their address
 - not voted in any election in the last 4 years.

Convicted felons, upon completion of a sentence, including probation and parole, automatically have their voting rights restored.

Registration and Voting

- No later than 25 days before an election, voters may register at the County Clerk's office or online at voteidaho.gov.
- Voters may also register at the polls on Election Day by providing proof of residence and a photo I.D.
- Idaho's closed primary law requires voters to declare a party affiliation. If no preference is indicated at registration, they will be entered into the poll book as unaffiliated. At the primary election, unaffiliated voters may choose to affiliate with a party.
- Voters must present a either an Idaho driver's license or photo I.D., a U.S. passport or federal I.D., a tribal I.D. or a concealed weapons license in order to vote.

Absentee Registration and Voting

- Voters absent from the county may register to vote by making a request for a registration card from the County Clerk or downloading one from the Vote Idaho website: www.voteidaho.gov. The registration card must be returned to the Clerk, postmarked no later than 25 days before the election.
- A registered voter may vote absentee by sending a written and personally signed request for an absentee ballot to the County Clerk. The request form is available on the Vote Idaho website. The application for an absentee ballot must be received by the County Clerk not later than the 6th day before election day. The 'voted' ballot must be received by the County Clerk no later than 8:00 p.m. on Election Day.
- A voter may vote at the early voting polling place at the Bannock County Elections Office, 141 N. 6th Avenue in Pocatello, up to the Friday before the election.

Election Schedule

- Party Primary Elections will be held on May 21, 2024. General Elections will be held on November 5, 2024. Taxing District and special questions elections may be held on May 21, 2024, and/or November 5, 2024. School District bond/levy elections may be held on May 21, 2024, August 27, 2024, or November 5, 2024.
- Idaho has a closed primary. A voter must affiliate with the Republican Party before March 15, 2024, in order to vote on the Republican ballot. All voters, regardless of affiliation, may vote on the Democratic ballot. Unaffiliated voters may affiliate with a party on Election Day.

SCHOOL DISTRICT

Voter Qualifications

- Voters must meet the same registration requirements as listed above, and when voting for members of the Board of Trustees, must live in the respective trustee zone. When voting in School District bond and supplemental levy elections, qualified voters must have lived in the School District for 30 days preceding the election. Voters must sign an oath at the time of the election stating they are qualified voters. Absentee voting and early voting are both conducted at the Bannock County Elections Office.

Election Schedule

- Trustee elections are held on the Tuesday following the first Monday in November of each odd year. Dates and times for bond and supplemental levy elections are set by the Board of Trustees and may be in May or November.
- Polling places are the same as for other elections. A map of Trustee Districts is on the School District website at www.sd25.us or contact the School District No. 25's Office at 208-232-3563.
- Approval Requirements
 - Two-thirds of those voting must approve the General Obligation Bond Elections and School Plant Facility Fund Levies. Supplemental Levy Elections require a simple majority.
