WHEREAS on February 3, 2021, the Idaho Supreme Court issued an Order entitled, “RE: COMMENCEMENT OF JURY TRIALS AND GRAND JURY IMPANELMENT,” (“Order”), the provisions of which govern the resumption of jury trials in Idaho; and,


WHEREAS the Order requires the Administrative District Judge to review the weekly COVID-19 incidence rates for each county in the Sixth Judicial District 10 days prior to the calendar week in which the jury trial(s) is scheduled to occur to determine if those incidence rates exceed the standards set in the Order; and,

WHEREAS the Administrative District Judge has determined upon review of the Weekly Publication of COVID-19 incidence rates that Caribou County and Franklin County do not meet the conditions for resuming jury trials as set forth in subsection 4(a) of the Order and Bannock County does not meet the conditions for resuming jury trials as set forth in subsection 4(b) of the Order.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the following Counties in the Sixth Judicial District SHALL NOT conduct jury trials for the week of April 12, 2021-April 16, 2021, and that any jury trial set to proceed during that time frame in that county shall be vacated and reset:

Bannock County
Caribou County
Franklin County
