The Board of Bannock County Commissioners wishes to guarantee that their appointments to the Advisory Board of the South East Idaho Behavioral Crisis Center will best serve the public interest of the County as well as be representative of a broad cross-section of the community. We ask you to provide us with the information that will best assist us in evaluating your application. While we appreciate all applicants' interest and willingness to volunteer, due to potential conflicts of interest, Bannock County employees are not permitted to serve on any volunteer board that is overseen by the County Commissioners.

The Advisory Board shall guide the implementation and operations of the Crisis Center to optimize use and ensure compliance to the Crisis Center model and shall assist with public outreach to help educate others as to the purpose and use of the Crisis Center and to promote the Crisis Center and its value to the public. The Crisis Center will operate 24/7, 365 days a year to assist adults in crisis, mental health challenges or substance abuse issues, to become stabilized and then connect them with community resources to help effectively deal with situations and avoid further crisis in Region 6. Region 6 is defined as Bannock, Bear Lake, Bingham, Caribou, Franklin, Oneida and Power Counties. The Bannock County Board of Commissioners will act as the fiscal agent for the Crisis Center.
