 - Students who meet the following guidelines may qualify for IDVR Services:
 - A student with a disability who may need assistance with transition to employment
 - A student receiving services through an IEP, a 504 plan, or an individualized health plan
 1. Contact the local Voc Rehab office at 236-6333 and schedule an intake interview
 2. Applicant must provide information to VR staff during an intake interview. Information requested by IDVR is necessary to begin the eligibility assessment process.
 3. Applicant agrees that he or she is available to complete the assessment process required to determine eligibility for VR services.
 4. At the intake interview, applicant provides a signed & dated application signature sheet to IDVR or makes an alternative request for application to IDVR.
